Important Things You Need to Know!

- Make sure registration forms have ALL the information filled in - especially emotional, medical & contact info
- All adults need a current background check. Please send it with the registration form
- Students who have turned 18 need a background check
- We have 22 \$50 scholarships available, granted on a first come/first served basis, limit 2 per church. If a student requests a scholarship and then does not plan to come to camp please let us know. There is always a waiting list. Please request these only if your church is unable to supply funds
- Cell phones DO NOT work at camp. Please leave phones, iPods, etc. locked in your vehicle. CCYM is not responsible for broken or stolen items. Please do not use these items during small and large group activities
- All activities are mandatory for adults and students
- If you are an adult assisting with a small group, please remain with that group the entire time they meet
- Make sure room curfews & lights out are respected. NO SHOWERS before 6:30 a.m.
- Please help us be good stewards of our camp. Put all trash in the trash cans, tie them off & leave outside the dorm door on Sunday morning. Please pick up the bathrooms and dorm rooms. Double check for anything left behind! We want you to go home with everything that you brought to camp!
